2022 PLAYER RECOGNITION REPORT

The 2022 Player Recognition program started on March 1 and ended September 30, 2022. The Player Recognition winners are calculated from the **PINK CARDS** that are filled out when a round is played at Riverbend with a RLGA Member. I am happy to share the results and winners of the various competitions.

70 members competed in the events by filling out a **PINK CARD**. Recognition pins are being distributed to those who requested them. If you did not request a pin but would like one, let us know and we will be sure to get it to you.

Payouts go to the top three winners in each category for the most Birdies, Most Chip-Ins, Most Eagles, Most Rounds Played, and Low Net Average. The payouts are added to each member's personal Riverbend account. A payout also goes to the Most Improved Player, based on WA Golf's calculations.

BIRDIE RACE: There were 39 ladies who recorded a total of 124 birdies. Every hole had at least 1 birdie, with hole #5 having the most with 24 followed by hole #13 with 20 and then hole #3 with 16. **Cathy Coleman** came in 1st with 15 birdies, followed by **Kathleen Paulson**, **Janine Chin**, and **Carol Logan** tying for 2nd with 7 birdies each.

CHIP-INS: There were 31 ladies who recorded a total of 48 chip-ins. Holes 1-17 had at least 1 chip-in. The hole with the most recorded chip-ins was #14 with 6. **Dee Taylor** came in 1st place with 5 chip-ins! **Vicki Hutsko** came in 2nd with 4, and we have a tie for 3rd place between **Cathy Kay and Carol Logan**, each having 3.

MOST ROUNDS PLAYED: A total of 376 rounds were submitted on the pink

cards. **Cathy Coleman** took 1st place with 28 rounds played; 2nd place goes to **Vicki Hutsko** with 22 rounds played and 3rd place goes to **Angela Hobbs** with 19 rounds played.

LOW NET AVERAGE (minimum of 5 recorded scores required): Stephanie Ticknor took 1st place with a low net average of 72.40; 2nd place goes to Karen Moerdyk with an average of 72.80, and 3rd place goes to Chris May with 73.23.

EAGLES AND/OR HOLE-IN-ONES: We had 3 ladies with an eagle this year! They are **Adrienne Bailey, Christina Millan, and Karen Moerdyk**. And **Adrienne Bailey** had a hole-in-one!

MOST IMPROVED PLAYER: Trinh Harter had the honor of being The Most Improved Player in 2022 with an improvement factor of 1.324. Honorable mentions also go to Sarah Lestock (1.229) and Cathy Kay (1.135).
